SWIMMING POOL RULES QUICK LIST

- 1. Pool hours: 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. Pool capacity: 23 people at one time
- 2. No lifeguard on duty. An adult must accompany children and young adults under the age of sixteen (16).
- 3. Proper attire (shoes/sandals & cover-up) required to and from the pool. No one is permitted in corridors and elevators barefoot, or wearing only a swimsuit.
- 4. Infants must wear disposable swimming diapers.
- 5. No running, shouting, ball playing, diving or roughhousing.
- 6. No shouting or loud calling between the pool areas and the lanais.
- 7. No diving or jumping into the pool is allowed.
- 7. Showers/foot showers required for the removal of <u>ALL</u> sand before entering the pool as sand clogs the drainage system. Sand removal from feet and shoes is required before entering the building.
- 8. No glass or food allowed.
- 9. No smoking allowed.
- 10. Only audio devices with earphones allowed.
- 12. Cell phone courtesy required. Email and texting are acceptable, but phone conversations should only be outside the pool area where no one can be disturbed.
- 11. No reserving of chairs/chaises allowed; they are to be available for everyone who is present at the pool.
- 13. Towels required on all pool furniture when individuals are using suntan oil or lotions.
- 14. Flotation devices other than children's safety equipment are not allowed in pool area. Small toys that do not constitute a safety hazard are allowed. Noodles are acceptable.
- 15. Pool hours between 2:00 P.M. and 3:00 P.M. (if adults are present) are reserved for adult use. Adults have the option to waive the rule.
- 17. The safety rope across the center of the pool should only be removed for swimming laps and reconnected after use.
- 16. <u>Upon leaving the pool area, chairs and chaises are to be straightened and returned to their original areas.</u> <u>Umbrellas should also be closed and secured.</u>
